Minutes of the Carlisle Township Board of Trustees
Budget Hearing and Regular Meeting
October 16, 2023

The Carlisle Township Board of Trustees met on October 16, 2023 at 7:00 PM. In attendance: Trustee Jared Smith, Trustee Berry Taylor, Trustee James Wright, Fiscal Officer Kimberly Fallon, Administrative Assistant William Oliver, Zoning Inspector Tim Ehrke, Road Superintendent Paul Sniezek and Fire Chief Stephen Higgins. Six (6) people signed the attendance sheet.

Public Participation

Resident Helen Kopp was in attendance to discuss the new housing development on Indian Hollow Road. She stated that with the increased traffic, it has become harder to turn onto Grafton Road. She just wanted to bring it to the attention of the Trustees. Trustee Smith stated that those are county roads and the Township cannot do anything about it.

Resident Jerry Hune questioned what was going on with trash collection. Trustee Smith stated that there is an upcoming meeting that he will be in attendance. The Township is moving forward and joining the consortium. He will keep the residents up to date as information is available. The notice was in the paper to start accepting bids for the consortium.

Trustee Comments

Trustee Smith stated that he was contacted by a resident about Republic Services possibly having a deal with Ford Motor Company to transfer contaminated soil to be used as cover at the landfill. He will keep the residents up to date as information is available.

Fiscal Officer Kimberly Fallons' Report

Administrative Assistant William Oliver's Report

There were 48 visits for dumpster days. Shred day will possibly be added to the next dumpster days.

The OTA Winter Conference information was submitted to the Trustees. He will need to know what events they would be attending.

The painting of the road department garage began with power washing.

Zoning Inspector Tim Ehrkes' Report

For the period of October 7 through October 16, there were seven (7) permits issued for a total of \$244.80.

The Carter hearing date is November 2nd at 1PM. He requested Trustees to attend.

On October 1st, Mr. Ehrke, Dan Derringer and Barry Pleska attended the BZA seminar hosted by Amherst Township given by the Lorain County Prosecutor. He found the information very helpful for today's concerns.

Road Superintendent Paul Sniezeks' Report

Leaf pick up dates October through December 15th.

Trustee Wright suggested choosing Bob's Truck and Tire as they are closer to the Township. Trustee Wright motioned to approve the purchase of tires for Truck 12 with a cost of \$1,260, Trustee Smith seconded; roll call, all ayes, motion carried.

Restoration of the headstones should start soon.

Three dumpsters were filled for dumpster days; collected 1,700 pounds of scrap and 50 gallons of oil.

Trustee Smith thanked the Sheriff department for allowing the use of the speed control devices on several roads in the Township. Trustee Wright mentioned that numerous communities are putting up solar powered permanent speed monitors and should the township consider purchasing one. Mr. Sniezek stated it would cost over \$3,000 for one device.

Fire Chief Stephen Higgins' Report

The fire department participated in an active shooter drill last week.


The fire department will be on the roads for Halloween on October 31st.
