# Record of Proceedings Minutes of the Carlisle Township Board of Trustees Regular Meeting October 3, 2022

The Carlisle Township Board of Trustees met on October 3, 2022 at 7:00 PM. In attendance: Trustee Berry Taylor, Trustee Jared Smith, Trustee James Wright, Fiscal Officer Kimberly Fallon, Administrative Assistant William Oliver, Zoning Inspector Tim Ehrke, and Fire Chief Stephen Higgins. Ten (10) people signed the attendance sheet.

#### **Public Participation**

Brentwood resident Ted Bansek was in attendance to see if there was any progress on speeding and ignoring of stop signs in Brentwood Lake. A Sheriff Deputy was in attendance and stated that an increase of law enforcement will be in the area and digital speed signs will also be set up. Several suggestions were discussed: removable speed bumps and the removal of the stop sign since the street is a straightaway. The residents were encouraged to video tape offenders and submit the evidence to the Sheriff.
